FARM TYPE TRACTOR

(Coverage While Towing Trailers, Farm Implements, or Other Equipment)

This endorsement is a part of the policy. Except for the changes this endorsement makes, all other provisions of the policy remain the same and apply to this endorsement.

1. **DEFINITIONS**

Trailer is changed to read:

Trailer means:

- 1. a trailer designed primarily for travel on public roads with a gross vehicle weight:
 - a. of 3,000 pounds or less; or
 - b. greater than 3,000 pounds while used for pleasure; or
- 2. a farm implement, farm wagon, or other equipment while being pulled by *your car*.

2. LIABILITY COVERAGE

Exclusions

The following is added:

THERE IS NO COVERAGE FOR AN *INSURED* FOR *BODILY INJURY* OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY ARISING OUT OF THE OPERATION OF A FARM IMPLEMENT OR OTHER EQUIPMENT.

3. UNINSURED MOTOR VEHICLE BODILY INJURY COVERAGE, and UNINSURED MOTOR VEHICLE BODILY INJURY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE COVERAGE

Exclusions

The following is added:

THERE IS NO COVERAGE FOR AN *INSURED* WHOSE *BODILY INJURY* RESULTS FROM THE OPERATION OF A FARM IMPLEMENT OR OTHER EQUIPMENT.
